Subject: ARCC NEW Grant Award Recommendations FY 20-21

Date: June 30, 2020

The Alzheimer’s Resource Coordination Center (ARCC) receives \$150,000 of state appropriations each year in order to award Dementia specific grants for Respite or Education programs for caregivers. Grants are awarded on a 2-year cycle. The first year is a competitive award of \$20,000 and the 2nd year is a non-competitive award of \$10,000. Therefore, it is recommended that FY 2020-2021 ARCC Funds be used to award 2nd year grantees (\$30,000) and as well as four new grants and one grant carry forward (\$100,000). Grantees are required to provide 100% match for ARCC funds. The grant award budget, therefore, is double the state award amount. Following is a list of all proposed grant activity starting July 1, 2020.
