**Purpose of Grant:** The ElderCare Trust Fund was created to develop innovative programs that help older adults remain in their homes and communities with maximum independence and dignity.

**Who May Apply:** Public and private non-profit agencies and organizations are eligible to apply.

**Level of Funding:** A one-year seed grant up to \$5,000. Continued funding for second may be available depending on funding and satisfactory outcomes.

**Funding Source:** Grants are made possible through the ElderCare Trust Fund Tax Check-Off Program and private donations.

**Application Due Date:** Applications are available at [aging.sc.gov](http://aging.sc.gov). The original plus nine (9) copies are due to our office no later than **October 18, 2019** at 4:00 pm. Faxes will not be accepted.
