Request for Applications: You are invited to submit a proposal with a short description of your project, a budget, and a budget narrative.

Purpose of Grant: The ElderCare Trust Fund was created to develop innovative programs that help older adults remain in their homes and communities with maximum independence and dignity.

Who May Apply: Public and private non-profit agencies and organizations are eligible to apply.

Level of Funding: Two organizations will receive a one-year seed grant up to \$10,000.

Funding Source: Grants are made possible through the ElderCare Trust Fund Tax Check-Off Program and private donations.

Application Due Date: Applications are available at aging.sc.gov. Complete applications may be submitted electrically, by mail or by hand-delivery. To mail or hand-deliver, submit the original plus nine (9) copies to our office by **4:00 PM on November 10, 2020**. Electronic copies may be submitted by emailing khightower@aging.sc.gov before **4:00 PM on November 10, 2020**. Only completed applications will be accepted.
