Purpose of Grant: The ElderCare Trust Fund was created to develop innovative programs that help older adults remain in their homes and communities with maximum independence and dignity.

Who May Apply: Public and private non-profit agencies and organizations are eligible to apply.

Level of Funding: Two organizations will receive a one-year seed grant up to \$10,000.

Funding Source: Grants are made possible through the ElderCare Trust Fund Tax Check-Off Program and private donations.

Application Due Date: Applications are available at aging.sc.gov. Fully completed applications must be received by our office no later than **March 31, 2023**. Only fully completed applications will be accepted.
