


Please explain how these funds will be used to provide a public benefit:

The purpose of this project is to expand senior services throughout Oconee County with a primary focus on congregate meals, transportation and community support. The direct allocation, in the amount of \$6.5 Million, to the Foothills YMCA is for capital expansion of the facility to establish a site for congregate meals and associated activities. Congregate meal programs benefit senior citizens by providing better nutrition and improving social connectedness. Additional resources will also be made available to qualified participants, including transportation to/from local senior-care facilities, as well as enrollment and engagement in programs, at no cost. The Foothills YMCA offers a variety of senior programs, including water exercise, yoga, stretching and toning classes, volunteer opportunities and social events. Oconee County will establish an application for the remaining \$500,000.00 for a need-based community support for senior facilities and providers across the County. The support of these facilities will allow for expanded services to help meet the needs of senior citizens, including health and wellness programs. A portion of the funds will be allocated to provide transportation for qualified seniors to the Foothills YMCA and Senior Centers. Oconee County anticipates an increase in senior participation in available services through increased opportunities and access to reliable transportation. The success of this project will be measured by the number of participants utilizing the programs and/or transportation services. The success of the project will be measured by the completion of the expansion of the Foothills YMCA, however, the number of meals provided at the congregate meal site, upon its completion, will also provide essential data as to the usefulness of the new site. Oconee County and its community partners aim to help seniors to access critical social/recreational activities, meals and other services to provide premium care and improve their quality of life.
