Subject: Grant Solicitation for 2020-2021 Programs for Alzheimer's Services

The SC Department on Aging, Alzheimer's Resource Coordination Center, is pleased to announce a solicitation for Alzheimer's services program grants for the grant year beginning July 1, 2020. The grant funds will be used to develop or expand (1) respite care programs that are dementia specific, including in-home, overnight, adult day services or social model group respite to support caregivers and promote a higher quality of life for the person with Alzheimer's disease or related disorders (ADRD), and the family or (2) to provide new or expanded educational programs for families and caregivers of persons with dementia and community service providers.

Please note, this funding will ONLY be available based on the passage of a continuing resolution by the SC General Assembly or an approved 2021 Fiscal Year Government Budget before July 1. Any delay in either of these appropriations will delay funding of the grants due to lack of funds available.
